**** Students not taking the NY State Pain Management course through the Dental Hygiene Program at NYU Dentistry must submit official completion of certification of local anesthesia/nitrous oxide training. This must be in the form of an official state continuing education certificate showing successful completion of the individual state mandated course. Continuing education credits do not count as transfer credits. State licensure in local anesthesia will be accepted.

The Department of Dental Hygiene and Dental Assisting submits external credits for transfer that are 'like for like' with our Dental Hygiene courses. Students must still have earned a total of 128 credits for degree conferral of the Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene from NYU Dentistry.
